Screening Questions. Part 1.

1. Name three technologies (created over the past 30 years) that have had a profound impact on society. Describe these technologies and why they have had such an impact.
2. Name three technologies you feel you could not live without, and why?
3. List three technologies that have failed. Why did they fail?
4. Apple has created an eco-system whereby their products ‘mostly’ work seamlessly together. Can you name and describe any other eco-systems other than what Apple has created?
5. What is the best book you read over the past few years, and why?
6. When you want to learn about something, name and describe your primary sources of information.
